1. What is the only mammal capable of true flight?

*Answer: The bat. Flying squirrels and other "flying" mammals only glide.*

2. In what year did the Titanic sink?

*Answer: 1912 (April 14-15). The ship struck the iceberg at 11:40pm on April 14 and sank at 2:20am April 15.*

3. What is the smallest country in the world by area?

*Answer: Vatican City — 0.49 km<sup>2</sup> (0.19 mi<sup>2</sup>).*

4. Which planet has the most moons in our solar system?

*Answer: Saturn, with 146 confirmed moons as of 2023, after a 2023 IAU update added 62. Previously Jupiter held the record.*

5. In what country did the espresso machine originate?

*Answer: Italy. Angelo Moriondo patented an early version in 1884; Luigi Bezzera commercialized it in 1901.*

### WHAT ELSE IS IN THE FULL PACK
